WHY TAKE NEBOSH HEALTH AND SAFETY AWARD AT WORK?

The qualification is designed for anyone who needs to understand the principles of health and safety as part of their job; this would include team leaders and supervisors, HR professionals, facilities managers and those training young people in a working environment. Many people take the NEBOSH Health and Safety at Work Award as a first step in a career in health and safety. It gives a valuable overview, and is a sound basis for further professional study.

This qualification will aid in implementing or maintaining a health and safety management system by having an awareness of common workplace hazards. It will also ensure that learners can apply the principles of risk assessment and understand how to control common workplace hazards. This knowledge can help reduce the number of accidents in the workplace, improving staff morale, and resulting in costs saving for the organization.

Overview:

The NEBOSH Health and Safety at Work Award looks at everyday solutions for general workplace health and safety issues. NEBOSH Health and Safety at Work Award provides a good basic understanding of health and safety and is ideal for individuals wanting a solid introduction to the subject, as well as organizations wanting to improve their safety culture. It will equip your workforce to identify and deal with hazards at work, helping to reduce accidents and achieving cost savings for the business.

Learning Outcomes:

Upon completion of this course, the participants should be able to:

- Understand why health and safety needs to be managed, ensuring effective processes are in place.
- Inspect the workplace, recognizing a range of common hazards, evaluating risks (taking account of current controls), recommending further control measures and 3 assigning actions.
